The position will report to Oil Plant Manager.

Main Responsibilities:

Running of Centrifuge Plant.

Supervision of Running of Water Treatment Effluent Plant, Chemical Treatment Plant, Biological Treatment Plant, Anaerobic Digester Plant

Offloading of late incoming loads on Oil Plant and Centrifuge plant

Watching Brief on Oil Plant Screens / Hot Settlers and Tank movements in conjunction with Solvent Plant Operator Night Shift.

Other duties:

Will also include drum yard work – fork lifting / sorting / processing of drums as detailed by Management depending on production issues if Centrifuge plant above is not operational for whatever reason.

It will include some occasional lone working when Solvent Plant is unmanned and therefore responsibility for running of Boilers.

Ability to work on own initiative and alone in all weathers is essential.

We are looking to cover 3 nights a week – currently Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday 18:00 to 06:00, 36 hours per week

This could be increased to 42 hours a week by working one Monday night every 2 weeks if required. Holidays in line with company policy.

Salary

After completion of training period the Salary grade in pay will be the same as for an Operator working 12 hour day shifts 7 days a week so would be £ 24,034.37 for an average 42 hour week

If the position is for a 36 hour week then the Salary would reduce accordingly to £ 20,600.88.

Pension payment by the company of 6% of salary will be paid additionally

Requirements

Full training will be provided but experience in waste, water or chemical Industries would be an advantage.

Experience of working at night or on varying shift patters would be an advantage.

Ability to work alone with little contact with management is important.
